The FALL recently caught up with Wisconsin Head Coach Barry Davis. We delve into the relationship that Coach Davis and Coach Zalesky had while in college.

Q: what years were you team mates w/Jim Zalesky (JZ) on the Hawkeyes?

BD: 1981-1984
